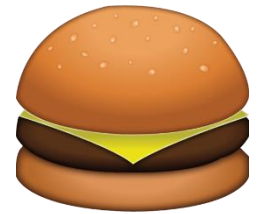

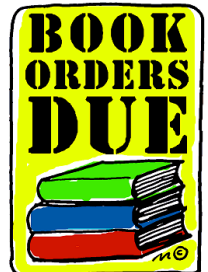
NOVEMBER 8th & 9th

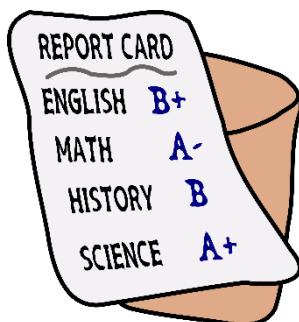


CAMELOT
