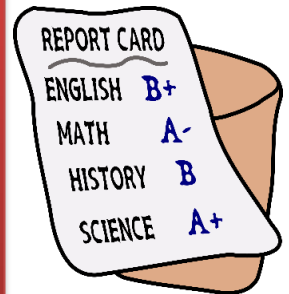

Hot lunches are being planned for November 30th and December 7th. Both menus are still being finalized at this time.

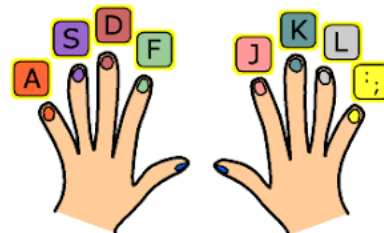


HOT LUNCH POSSIBILITY
