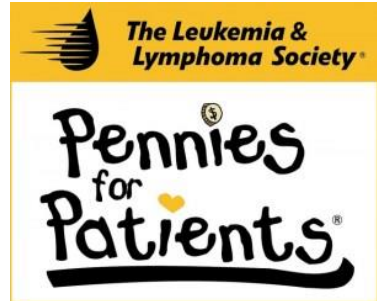
MISSION PROJECT
